THE EXTRAORDINARY JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

Pope Francis has declared that the Church worldwide will observe a Jubilee Year of Mercy from December 8th to November 20, 2016 (The Feast of Christ the King). The Pope made the declaration on April 11 of this year in front of the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. The Holy Door, usually bricked up, is opened during a jubilee year. In announcing the Jubilee Year the Holy Father pointed out our "responsibility to be a living sign of the Father's love in the world." Jubilee Years occur about every 25 years. The last one was in 2000. However, the Holy Father may call a Holy Year for a particular purpose as these holy years are filled with special celebrations and pilgrimages, strong calls for conversion and repentance, and the opportunity to experience God's grace, and specifically in this Jubilee Year to focus on God's Mercy.

An absolute clear experience of God's Mercy is the Sacrament of Reconciliation. To know that we are able to turn our face back to God, to confess that we have sinned and to be absolved of that sin in the hope of our deep and full conversion to the ways of Jesus is essential mercy. During this Advent Season, as we prepare for Christmas and as we begin this Year of Mercy there is no better way to open your heart to Jesus and the Mercy of God. We are so blessed to have the priests of the Shrine of St. Joseph who are available for confession Monday through Friday from 10 AM—Noon and 1:30-5 , Saturday 3-5 and Sunday 1-3. In addition to confession scheduled here on Saturday afternoon the opportunity for confession will be offered during Advent on Tuesday, December 15 and 22nd from 7—9 PM.

Give Jesus the best Christmas gift, yourself. As we begin this Year of mercy there will be opportunities presented in the parish throughout the year. After the 7 PM Mass on Tuesday evening there will be a brief teaching on the words of Pope Francis in *Misericordiae Vultus* in the Church Meeting Room. Printed below is the prayer composed by the Holy Father for the Year of Mercy which we will pray at Mass. Prayer cards have been ordered and will be placed in the vestibule for your use. In this Jubilee Year may we open our hearts to God's Mercy and be more merciful in our care for and responsibilities towards one another.

Prayer of Pope Francis for the Jubilee Year of Mercy

Lord Jesus Christ, you have taught us to be merciful like the heavenly Father, and have told us that whoever sees you sees Him. Show us your face and we will be saved.

Your loving gaze freed Zacchaeus and Matthew from being enslaved by money; the adulteress and Magdalene from seeking happiness only in created things; made Peter weep after his betrayal, and assured Paradise to the repentant thief. Let us hear, as if addressed to each one of us, the words that you spoke to the Samaritan woman: "If you knew the gift of God!"

You are the visible face of the invisible Father, of the God who manifests his power above all by forgiveness and mercy: let the Church be your visible face in the world, its Lord risen and glorified.

You willed that your ministers would also be clothed in weakness in order that they may feel compassion for those in ignorance and error: let everyone who approaches them feel sought after, loved, and forgiven by God.

Send your Spirit and consecrate every one of us with its anointing, so that the Jubilee of Mercy may be a year of grace from the Lord, and your Church, with renewed enthusiasm, may bring good news to the poor, proclaim liberty to captives and the oppressed, and restore sight to the blind.

We ask this of you, Lord Jesus, through the intercession of Mary, Mother of Mercy; you who live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit for ever and ever. Amen.

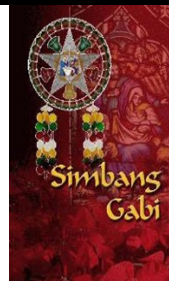
SIMBANG GABI
